Part-time faculty must be available to teach three to six hours per week. Classes are typically scheduled within college hours of operation, Monday to Thursday between 8:00am and 10:00pm, and Fridays between 8:00am and 6:00pm. Teaching and college-related activities may be on-site or online via remote delivery as required. Conestoga has campuses in Kitchener, Waterloo, Cambridge, Guelph, Stratford, Ingersoll, and Brantford.

- Create and maintain a positive learning environment that supports the diversity of students' cultures, educational backgrounds, and learning styles
- Collaborate and build relations with other program faculty

- Certificate of Apprenticeship and Certificate of Qualification or Diploma/Degree in related field with demonstrable hands-on experience
- Minimum of five years of related industry experience
- Previous adult or post-secondary teaching experience is considered an asset

- Ability to work independently and collaboratively as part of an academic team
